# NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ The stock market tumbled again Thursday after another drop in the euro and disappointing U.S. employment news. The Dow Jones Industrials Average was down more than 300 points at mid-day. At the bell the Dow closed down 376.36 points at 10,068.01.
- ♦ BP concedes that more oil than it estimated is gushing into the Gulf of Mexico. A BP spokesman says a tube inserted into the leaking pipe last weekend is capturing 210,00 gallons a day, but some is still escaping. Meantime, heavy crude has washed into Louisiana's wetlands for the first time.
- ♦ Mexican President Felipe Calderon has told Congress that he strongly disagrees with the new Arizona law that requires police to question people about their immigration status if there is reason to suspect they are in the country illegally.
- ♦ A California judge issued a warrant Thursday for actress Lindsay Lohan's arrest after she failed to attend a mandatory probation hearing. The judge revoked Lohan's probation and said if she makes bail she will be required to wear an alcohol-monitoring bracelet and submit to random weekly drug testing. Lohan has been on probation since August 2007 in connection with drug and driving charges. Her attorney says her passport was stolen at the Cannes Film Festival and she was not able to return to Los Angeles for the hearing.
