◆ HIGHWAY 307 CRASH CLAIMS DELANO MAN

William B. Mozley, 39, of Delano was killed late Tuesday afternoon in a one-vehicle wreck on Highway 307 just inside McMinn County. State troopers say Mozley was driving his pickup truck north on Highway 307 when he ran off the right side of the road in a curve. He over-corrected, and the truck veered across the road, hit the guard rail on the left side, and flipped. Mozley was ejected and the truck landed on top of him.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ BP has launched its latest bid to plug the gushing well in the Gulf of Mexico by force-feeding it heavy drilling mud, a maneuver known as a "top kill" that has never been tried before, 5,000 feet underwater.

◆ Space shuttle Atlantis returned from its final voyage Wednesday, closing out a quarter-century flying career and safely bringing back six astronauts from a successful space station mission.

◆ Stocks tanked Wednesday even after gains in durable goods orders and home sales helped reassure traders that the economy is recovering. The DJIA closed at 9,974.45; down 69.30 points.

◆ Despite much public opposition, a New York City community board has voted to support a plan to build a Muslim mosque and cultural center near ground zero. A member of the board called the project a "seed of peace".

◆ Airline officials are trying to figure out how a sleeping passenger was left aboard a flight for four hours after it landed in Philadelphia. According to police and the Transportation Security Administration, the passenger didn't wake up when her United Express flight from Dulles airport outside Washington landed shortly after midnight Tuesday. At about 4 a.m., a cleaning crew found her.
