## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- BP officials say the so-called "top kill" procedure to plug the blown-out oil well in the Gulf of Mexico with mud and concrete seems to be working. New estimates showed the spill has already surpassed the Exxon Valdez as the worst in U.S. history.
- ♦ President Obama says the federal government has been in charge of the response effort from the moment the oil spill began. He announced a series of new steps to deal with the aftermath of the spill, including a moratorium on drilling permits for six months and suspension of planned exploration drilling in the Gulf and off the coasts of Alaska and Virginia. Obama also denounced the oil industry's "cozy and sometimes corrupt" ties with government regulators.
- ♦ Stocks had another turnaround Thursday and rocketed higher after China reassured investors it doesn't plan to sell the European debt it holds. The Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 10,258.99; up 284.54 points.
- ♦ The upcoming Atlantic hurricane season could be one of the most active on record. NASA forecasters predict between 14 to 23 tropical storms, including up to seven major hurricanes. Three of those hurricanes could be major storms with sustained winds of over 111 mph.
