♦ MONROE DEPUTY CLEARED IN MILLER CASE

The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation has cleared Monroe County Sheriff's Department Captain Kenny Hope as a person of interest in the ongoing Jim Miller homicide investigation. Hope has returned to his normal duties. Meantime, the TBI says Miller had been shot three times in the head before he was stuffed into the trunk of his car and the car was set on fire. Investigators are looking into possible conflicts or disputes Miller may have had with people going back several years. Miller was the Monroe County Election Commission Chairman.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ A tropical depression racing toward the Gulf of Mexico is increasing pressure on BP and the federal government to decide whether to evacuate dozens of ships from the site of the ruptured oil well.
- ♦ Congress has passed and sent to the President legislation to restore unemployment benefits to people who have been out of work for six months or more.
- ♦ Stocks surged Thursday after strong revenue reports by several companies, including UPS and 3M. The Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 10,322.30; up 201.77 points.
- Six people were killed and dozens more were injured when a Greyhound bus crashed on a highway in California's Central Valley on Thursday. Police say the bus driver swerved to avoid hitting an overturned minivan.
- ♦ The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists have issued new guidelines saying that most women who have had a C-section, and many who have had two, should be allowed to try labor with their next baby.
- French police have arrested an Air France flight attendant on suspicion of stealing thousands of dollars in cash, cards, and jewelry as passengers slept on long haul flights.
