♦ FIRST SENATOR FROM McMINN SINCE 1974

Come January, State Representative Mike Bell of Riceville will move



over to the Senate chambers. Bell defeated Lou Patten of Cleveland in last Thursday's Republican primary for Senate District 9 by a 68% margin. The district includes McMinn, Bradley, Meigs, and Polk counties. Bell told The Morning Fax that he was "surprised and humbled" by the margin of victory. He will be the first state Senator from McMinn County in decades. Ironically, the last state Senator from

McMinn County was also from Riceville. He was Dr. Calvin L. Cannon, who served from 1967-1974. Bell replaces Dewayne Bunch who is from Cleveland. Our Senator before Bunch, was Gene Elsea from Spring City. Harry T. Burn from Niota was a state Senator from 1949 to 1953, and Paul Cantrell from Etowah was a state Senator in 1942 and in 1944.


