LOCAL & AREA NEWS

◆ INGLESIDE STUDENTS SENT HOME-NO POWER

Students at Ingleside Elementary School in Athens got one more unexpected day of summer vacation Tuesday due to a power failure. There was a problem in the underground electrical cable that feeds Ingleside School. Athens Utilities Board crews could not dig to try to find the problem until the location of phone lines, gas lines, and other underground utilities in the area could be marked. As a result, school officials made the decision around 8:30 a.m. to cancel classes and send the students home. Ingleside School will be open today.

◆ NIOTA TEEN DIES IN CYCLE CRASH

Heath Delane Henley, 15, of Niota died Monday evening from injuries received in a motorcycle crash on Butler Road in Meigs County. He was reported to be conscious and alert at the scene. His family took him home. After he began having difficulty breathing, the family called an ambulance. The teen was taken to Athens Regional Medical Center's emergency room where he died.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ Former Alaska Senator Ted Stevens, 86, and four other people were killed when their plane crashed in remote southwest Alaska. Stevens and the others were headed to a fishing trip. Ex-NASA Chief Sean O'Keefe and his son were also on the plane. Both O'Keefe and his son survived the crash, but are reported to be severely injured.

◆ Approaching storms forced crews to suspend drilling the final stretch of a relief well aimed at shooting a permanent underground plug into BP's broken oil well in the Gulf of Mexico.

◆ New York Democrat Congressman Charles Rangel says he is not resigning, despite 13 charges of ethical wrongdoing. In a rambling floor speech yesterday, the former House Ways and Means Committee chairman pleaded with the ethics committee, "Don't leave me swinging in the wind." He said he made mistakes but is not corrupt.

◆ The Federal Reserve says it will leave interest rates alone. The Fed also said it will use money from its investments in maturing mortgage bonds to buy government debt. On Wall Street, the Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 10,644.25; down 54.50 points.

◆ The head of the World Health Organization says the H1N1 swine flu pandemic is over and the global outbreak turned out to be much less severe than was feared a year ago.

√ A customer at a North Carolina Krispy Kreme got some extra "dough" in his box of hot glazed doughnuts. Police say a clerk at the store accidentally handed over a box of doughnuts that also contained the store's cash receipts. The manager had put the cash in the doughnut box as a safeguard against theft.

√ Police have released a security video from a McDonald's in Ohio that shows a woman punching two restaurant employees and smashing a drive-thru window because she couldn't get Chicken McNuggets for breakfast. The woman, who claimed she was drunk, was sentenced to 60 days in jail and ordered to pay for the broken window.

√ A New York judge has granted bail for a JetBlue flight attendant accused of cursing out a passenger on the plane's public address system, grabbing some beer from the galley, and leaving the plane on an emergency escape slide. Police say Steven Slater lost his temper after a dispute with a passenger. He was charged with criminal mischief and reckless endangerment.

This Date In History-Aug. 11

1909 - The S.O.S. distress signal was first used by an American ship, the Arapahoe, off Cape Hatteras, North Carolina.

1925 - Television host Mike Douglas was born. During the early days of his career, he was a soloist with Kay Keyser's orchestra. Douglas died on Aug. 11, 2006, at age 81.

1934 - The first federal prisoners arrived at the island prison known as Alcatraz in San Francisco Bay.

1941 - Glenn Miller and his Orchestra recorded "Elmer's Tune" on Bluebird Records.

1946 - Country singer John Conlee was born. One of his biggest hit records was "Rose Colored Glasses."

1953 - Wrestler and actor Hulk Hogan was born.

1965 - Six days of riots and looting broke out in the predominantly black Watts section of Los Angeles. The riots took place in reaction to the arrest by white police officers of a black man suspected of drunk driving. When the riots finally ended, 34 people had been killed and over 2,000 were injured.

1984 - President Ronald Reagan nearly created an international incident when he joked during a voice test for a radio address that he had "signed legislation that will outlaw Russia forever. We begin bombing in five minutes."
