#### **♦ FRANK IS NEW DISTRICT LT. GOVERNOR**

Diane Frank of Athens was elected Lt. Governor of Zone 5 at the

#### NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- President Obama says Congress should make passing a package of small business tax cuts and credit incentives its first order of business when it gets back from summer vacation. He says he will have other specific ideas for improving the economy in the weeks ahead.
- ♦ On Wall Street, the Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 10,009.73; down 140.92 points on Monday.
- ♦ Hurricane Earl lashed the northeastern Caribbean on Monday and was on a course that could threaten the eastern United States later this week. The storm blew roofs off buildings and damaged utility poles on the tiny British territory of Anguilla.
- ♦ The motorcycle racing community is mourning the death of a promising 13-year-old rider in a crash at Indianapolis Motor Speedway. Peter Lenz of Vancouver, Washington, fell off his bike during the warmup lap for Sunday's first race and was run over by another motorcycle driven by a 12-year-old. Lenz died several hours later. He was the youngest driver ever killed at the 101-year-old speedway.
- ♦ A venomous rattlesnake that escaped from the Atlanta Zoo has been found across the street, about 100 yards away. The snake had been clubbed to death by a resident who was unaware the reptile was on the lam.
- ♦ Forget the DOW and the GDP. Here's the latest economic indicator: The U.S. birth rate has fallen to its lowest level in a century as many couples have apparently decided they cannot afford more mouths to feed.
