LOCAL & AREA NEWS

◆ BEER SELLERS GET SLAP ON WRIST

The Athens City Council has slapped the wrists of four convenience stores caught selling beer to minors. Meeting as the Athens Beer Board, the council members voted to fine two Kangaroo Express Stores \$1,500 each or suspend their beer permits for 30 days. The Super Mart and Stop N Go #2 were each given the choice of a \$2000 fine or 40 day suspensions. All four convenience stores sold beer to a Monroe County deputy sheriff who is under the age of 21 in a sting operation this past April.

◆ TEENAGE CAR CRASH VICTIMS REMEMBERED

Funeral services will be held today for Alex Wattenbarger, one of two teens killed in a car crash on County Road 130 last Saturday morning. Services for the other victim, Matt Martin, were held Wednesday night. Meantime, a makeshift memorial has been erected at the scene of the one-vehicle crash. Friends are planning to hold a memorial for both young men at the site of the wreck next month.



NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ Several aspects of the nation's new health care law go into effect today. Some people will no longer have to pay copays or meet their deductibles for such preventive care as flu vaccines, mammograms, and colonoscopies. If you go to an emergency room outside your health plan's network, you won't be charged extra. Lifetime limits on insurance benefits will be removed. Insurers can no longer deny coverage to children with pre-existing conditions and parents can keep their adult children on their health plans until age 26. Some of these benefits apply only to new health insurance plans or existing plans that change substantially on or after Sept. 23.

◆ A new book by Bob Wooward titled "Obama's Wars" says President Obama's top advisers spent much of the past 20 months arguing about policy and turf and doubting whether the president's strategy in Afghanistan will work.

◆ Authorities confirm that the remains of Theresa Parker have been located in Chattooga County, Ga. more than three years after she disappeared. Theresa Parker was a Walker Co. Ga Sheriff's dispatcher when she disappeared in March of 2007. Her husband, Sam Parker, a Lafayette, Ga police officer, came under suspicion and was convicted of malice murder in 2009 and was sentenced to life in prison.
