LOCAL & AREA NEWS

◆ GRANT MONEY COMING TO AREA

The city of Athens will receive a \$150,000 state grant to construct a steel gazebo at Knight Park and a restroom facility at Market Park in downtown Athens.

The libraries in Athens and Decatur will each receive \$21,622 in grants to provide computers, education courses, and job skill training.

✓ Athens Utilities Board will flush water lines and fire hydrants throughout the city beginning at 4 p.m. today. AUB will also drain a water reservoir on Highpoint Drive which will result in water running in drainage ditches along Crestway Drive and in parts of the Ridgeways Subdivision.

✓ The Athens Parks Department and the McMinn Regional Humane Society will sponsor the 9th annual Bark in the Park program tomorrow from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Athens Regional Park Lake Pavilion. Events will include a Wiener Dog Race and a Dog Show with prizes for smallest dog, tallest dog, cutest dog, best costume, and best fetch/trick. Registration begins at 9:30 a.m.

MORE LOCAL NEWS

◆ State troopers arrested four people for a "phishing" operation. Trooper Kevin Hoppe and Sergeant James VanDyke stopped a Michigan car at 2 a.m. Thursday after spotting it driving erratically on I-75 at mile marker 45 in McMinn County. It was occupied by four people from Detroit. Inside, the troopers found computer equipment, blank checks, tax returns, and personal information belonging to third parties. The investigation revealed the computer equipment was stolen in Detroit and the driver was a federal fugitive. All four occupants were booked at the McMinn County Jail on several charges, including theft and criminal simulation. The Secret Service is investigating.

◆ John Nevans, 67, of Dayton has been charged with the murder of his former business partner, 79-year-old Ronald Kronholm. Kronholm was found shot to death inside his home in Tellico Village in Loudon County last Thursday. The two men had built nearly 100 homes in the Tellico Village area over the past decade, but had lost money since the collapse of the housing market.

◆ Unemployment in McMinn County held steady at 11.8% in August. The rate in Meigs Co. was 12.3% and 12.6% in Monroe Co. **REMINDER: Monday, October 4, is the last day to register to vote for the November elections.**
