## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ One by one, the miners who spent 69 agonizing days deep inside a mine in Chile, have been hoisted to freedom. They wore oxygen masks and dark glasses to protect their eyes from unfamiliar daylight. They emerged healthier than expected and several were clean-shaven. They were flown by helicopter to a nearby hospital where they will be observed for 48 hours.

◆ Officials in all 50 states have launched a joint investigation into allegations that mortgage companies mishandled documents and broke laws in foreclosing on hundreds of thousands of homeowners.

◆ Stocks rose on Wednesday after stronger-than-expected corporate earnings reports and upbeat economic data from China. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 11,096.08; up 75.68 points.




