## LOCAL & AREA NEWS

### ◆ ATHENS WOMAN STABBED BY NEIGHBOR

Athens Police were called to the Lee Manor Apartments Thursday morning around 3 a.m. after 2 residents got into a fight and one of them was stabbed. Tamara Johnson told police that her neighbor, Tasha McSpadden, pulled a knife and stabbed her five times. Johnson was taken to Athens Regional Medical Center and treated for non-life threatening injuries. Tasha McSpadden was arrested and charged with aggravated assault.

### ◆ McMINN COUNTY RECEIVES MAJOR GRANT

Tennessee's Health Commissioner, Susan R. Cooper, was in Athens yesterday to present to the county health department \$300,000 in federal funding from the USDA's Women, Infants, & Children's Supplemental Nutrition Program. The money will be used to expand the McMinn County Health Department by about 1400 square feet. The health department provides WIC services to about 1300 clients. ## MORE LOCAL NEWS

◆ The Bowater Paper Mill in Calhoun reported an explosion and fire shortly after 5 p.m. Thursday. Initial reports indicated that the incident occurred in the coal bunker area of the mill. The fire was brought under control within about 40 minutes. One employee was injured and was flown to Erlanger Medical Center. Several rural fire departments responded to the scene, including three medical helicopters.
