◆ TIME TO REMOVE THE CAMPAIGN SIGNS

The Athens Codes Enforcement Department reminds candidates that all election signs should be taken down by this Friday. The city's policy is for all political signs to be promptly removed ten days after any election takes place.

◆ SLEEP LAB GETS ACCREDITATION

The Athens Regional Sleep Diagnostic Center has received notification that it has been approved for accreditation by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine. The Sleep Center started in 1997 with two patient rooms. Now, it has four bedrooms connected by bathrooms, a large area for office and staff, and is in a setting that more resembles a resort hotel than a clinic.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ The U.S. Supreme Court has turned down the first preliminary challenge to President Obama's health care overhaul. The decision to reject an appeal from a former Republican state lawmaker in California was no surprise because a federal appeals court has yet to consider the case.

◆ President Obama wrapped up his first visit to India by backing India for a permanent seat on the United Nations Security Council.

◆ US Airways says it will add 500 flight attendants and pilots next year to cover planned retirements and attrition.

◆ Australia's Qantas Airways has grounded its fleet of A380's for at least three more days as it investigates oil leaks that might have caused the engine explosion on one of its flight's last week.

◆ A teenager was stomped, kicked, and punched to death at a weekend house party in Douglasville, Georgia, after he walked by a group who decided to pounce on the next male who passed by them. Four people have been charged with murder.

◆ A 12-year-old chimpanzee is headed to a sanctuary in Brazil after animal rights workers discovered him smoking cigarettes to entertain visitors at a zoo in Beirut, Lebanon.
