STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

◆ BIG TURN-OUT FOR WETLAND PROJECT



Nearly 100 volunteers from TWC, the Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, Keep McMinn Beautiful, and several churches converged on the E.G. Fisher Library Saturday morning to plant around 700 native trees and shrubs. Shawn Lindsey, Athens Public Works Direc-

tor, says about 2,000 flowers will be planted in the same area next spring. The project was designed for flood control and to attract wildlife as well as beautify the area. The plants were chosen because of their ability to attract natural predators of mosquitoes.



NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL NEWS

◆ A BOLO was issued Friday for an inmate who escaped from the Monroe County jail. Christopher Chittum was serving time for the armed robbery of the Hampton Inn of Athens. Chittum is a white male, is 5-11 and weighs 235 lbs. He fled in a Gold Chevy Malibu driven by Samantha Stafford. He is considered dangerous. Call 911 if you spot them.



◆ D.A. Steve Bebb says he has received a copy of the autopsy report on the body of Monroe County Election Commissioner Jim Miller, whose body was found in a burning car last summer. Bebb says if he releases the report now, it would compromise the investigation.

◆ Former U.T. student David Kernell was sentenced to 1 year and 1 day in jail for hacking into Sarah Palin's e-mail account in 2008. The judge says he can serve the time in a Knoxville "half-way house" and then will be on probation for 3 more years.
