♦ NO SCHOOL AGAIN TODAY

- > Streets and roads in Athens, McMinn County, and Meigs County are still treacherous enough to prompt school officials to call off classes again Wednesday. All public schools and Fairview Christian Academy will be closed.
- > The Athens Public Works Department has been unable to provide curbside trash collection on the regular schedule this week due to the weather. Crews continue to salt and plow the residential streets. The revised garbage schedule is as follows: Monday's trash will be collected on Thursday. Tuesday's trash will be collected on Friday. Wednesday's trash will be collected on Saturday. Trash collection for Thursday and Friday will be on the regular schedule.
- > The City of Etowah announces that due to weather conditions, all residential and commercial trash will be picked up on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of this week.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ Doctors say Arizona Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords is breathing on her own, four days after being shot in the head. They say she is alert and responding to them.
- ♦ The parents of 22-year-old Jared Loughner, the man charged with trying to assassinate Congresswoman Giffords, are reported to be devastated and guilt-ridden. A neighbor says Loughner's mother has been in bed, crying nonstop since the shooting rampage last Saturday.
- ♦ The president of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, Tom Donohue, says the group backs Republican efforts to dismantle the Obama administration's healthcare overhaul. The Republican-led House was set to conduct a vote to repeal the healthcare law this week, but it has been delayed due to the shooting of Rep. Giffords.
- ♦ Alaska's main oil pipeline is expected to restart this week with plans to bypass a leaking section that forced the line to shut down last Saturday, idling 12 percent of U.S. oil production.
- ◆ Strong financial reports from Alcoa and Sears helped push stock prices higher on Tuesday. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 11,671.88; up 34.43.
