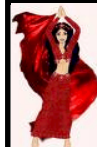
◆ EMERGENCY BLOOD NEED

Medic Regional Blood Center has issued an emergency appeal for all blood types because inclement weather has led to a cancellation of many blood drives. At this point, Medic does not have enough blood type O Positive and B Negative to fill the area's hospital orders. Medic will be set-up inside the city courtroom at the Athens Municipal Building Friday, Jan. 14, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

CLARIFICATION: On Monday, we reported two weekend home invasions, one in McMinn County and the other in Meigs County. Meigs County Sheriff Jackie Melton says an investigation has determined that the Meigs County incident was not a home invasion and had no connection to the McMinn County incident. Sheriff Melton does confirm that the Meigs County incident involved an alleged rape, but was not a home invasion.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Sarah Palin calls the rush to pin blame on conservatives for last Saturday's shooting in Tucson, Arizona, a "blood libel." Palin says acts of monstrous criminality begin and end with the criminals who commit them. She said the attempts by journalists and pundits to try to blame the shooting on conservatives and talk radio is "reprehensible."
- ◆ The suspect in the Tucson shooting was stopped by a wildlife officer less than three hours before the deadly attack after he ran a red light. The officer let Jared Loughner go with a warning after he found no outstanding warrants on Loughner.
- ◆ Stocks rose on Wednesday after a healthy bond sale in Portugal eased nervousness about the European debt crisis. The Dow Jones Industrials closed at 11,755.44; up 83.56 points.
- ◆ David Nelson, the last remaining member of the Nelson family from the popular TV show "The Adventures of Ozzie and Harriet" has died from colon cancer. He was 74.
- ◆ The winter storm that shut down much of the South has dumped over two feet of snow on Connecticut. State police responded to about 500 spinouts, fender-benders, and stranded vehicles. The storm also hit other New England states.
