STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

◆ TVA TO LOWER RATES

TVA will lower its rates by 1.5% in February. That will mean a reduction of between \$1 and \$2 for the average residential utility bill. The decrease stems from a projection of milder weather.

◆ IT'S NOW GOVERNOR BILL HASLAM

Bill Haslam was sworn in as Tennessee's 49th governor on Saturday. In his inaugural address, he warned that "difficult choices face us" as his administration tries to close the state's budget gap.

Meantime, State Senator Mike Bell of Riceville has been named Vice-Chairman of the Senate Government Operations Committee and Secretary of the Judiciary Committee. He will also serve on the Environment, Conservation and Tourism Committee. Rep. John Forgety was named to the Agriculture, Education, and Children and Family Affairs committees.

√ Today is Martin Luther King, Jr., Day. It's a holiday for state and federal government offices, banks, public schools, and the post office. The McMinn County Commission will not meet tonight or February 21st. Instead, there will be a special called session on Thursday, February 3rd, at 7:30 p.m.

√ Tennessee Wesleyan College will host a Martin Luther King, Jr., Day Celebration tonight at 7 at Townsend Auditorium. The Athens Community Choir will perform. The event is free.

NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- ♦ Doctors say they continue to be satisfied with Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords' recovery from a gunshot wound to her head. On Saturday, they removed her from a ventilator and inserted a breathing tube into her neck. The next test will be to see if she is able to talk.
- ♦ In a bizarre twist to the Arizona shootings, a man who was wounded in the attack was arrested and taken for a psychiatric exam after an outburst at a town meeting being taped for a special edition of ABC-TV's "This Week." James Eric Fuller was detained after he took a picture of a tea party leader and yelled "you're dead."
- ♦ Two senators from different parties say they'll skip tradition and sit together during President Obama's State of the Union address. The decision by Republican Tom Coburn of Oklahoma and Democrat Chuck Schumer of New York comes amid calls for greater civility in political discourse following the Arizona shootings.
- ♦ Nebraska's 17-year-old Teresa Scanlan has become the youngest person to be crowned Miss America. She wowed the judges by wearing a white evening gown and by playing a rousing rendition of "White Water Chopped Sticks" on the piano.


