STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

◆ MARCHING AGAINST METH

The next "March Against Meth" is scheduled for this Saturday morning at 8 at the Niota Police Station. Pastor Jerry Shirk of the Knoxville Avenue Baptist Church invites all concerned Christians to join in Marching Against Meth in McMinn County. Marches are being held each Saturday through April 16th at different locations. Pastor Shirk says it is far past time for Christians to stand, speak out, and take our county back and **AWAKE!**

◆ YARD SALE SIGN REMINDER

Now that Spring is here, yard sales will be held every weekend in Athens. The Athens Community Development Department issues this reminder about the city's sign regulations:

1. No yard sale signs shall be placed within any public right of way.
2. Yard sale signs shall not be erected or otherwise fixed to any pole, tree, fence, or any object within the right-of-way of any street.
3. No person shall fasten any yard sale sign on any public or private property unless legally authorized to do so.
4. The general rule of thumb for placement of the signs is that they should be located at least two feet behind any utility pole...and no yard sale sign shall ever be affixed to any utility pole.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A U.S. fighter jet crashed in eastern Libya's rebel-held area on Tuesday, but both crew members parachuted to safety. Military officials say the plane crashed because of mechanical problems.
- ◆ Workers at the damaged nuclear plant in Japan have hooked up power lines to all six of the reactor units. Now, officials hope to start up the water pumps in the plant's crucial cooling system.
- ◆ Automakers Honda and Toyota say they have delayed plans to restart assembly lines in Japan because of a shortage of necessary parts. Several of their parts suppliers suffered major damage from the earthquake and tsunami.
- ◆ U.S. stock prices edged lower on Tuesday following three days of gains. The DJIA closed at 12,018.63; down 17.90 points.
- ◆ A federal judge has ordered Jared Lee Loughner, the college dropout charged in January's shooting rampage in Arizona in which Rep. Gabrielle Giffords was wounded, to undergo a mental evaluation in Missouri to see if he is competent to stand trial.
- ◆ NFL owners have voted to move kickoffs to the 35-yard line instead of the 30. However, the ball will still be brought out to the 20-yard line after touchbacks. Owners also voted to make all scoring plays reviewable by the replay official and referee.

THIS DAY IN HISTORY - March 23

1775 - American patriot Patrick Henry declared, "Give me liberty, or give me death!" He spoke those words while addressing the Virginia Provincial Convention. He was urging that the Virginia militia be armed for defense of the colony against England.

1925 - A law against evolution was enacted in Tennessee, making it a crime for a teacher in any public school to teach any theory that contradicted the Bible's account of man's creation. Within two months, a teacher in Dayton was indicted and later convicted in the famous "Monkey Trial." John Scopes was fined \$100.

1929 - Roger Bannister was born. He was the first athlete to run a mile in less than 4 minutes.

1965 - Astronauts Virgil "Gus" Grissom and John Young were launched from Cape Kennedy aboard Gemini-3 to become the first two-man American space team to go into orbit.
