State & Local News

◆ WATTS BAR EVACUATION PLAN REVIEWED

As a result of the nuclear plant crisis in Japan, officials in the counties within a 10-mile radius of the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant are reviewing their evacuation plans. Meigs County Emergency Management Director Tony Finnell recommends everyone have a three-day supply of food, prescription medicines, and other necessities on hand in case of an emergency at the plant. Rhea County's Emergency Management Director says the county's evacuation route is being changed to send students up U.S. 27 to Harriman rather than up Highway 68 toward Crossville. And McMinn County's Emergency Management Director, Betty Hamby, says training sessions with emergency responders will be held in May. All three counties provide free calendars with evacuation information for residents living within 10 miles of the plant.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Moammar Gadhafi's ground forces recaptured a strategic oil town Wednesday as they beat-back a rebel advance toward the capital city of Tripoli. Western powers continued with new airstrikes in an attempt to weaken Gadhafi's military. There were also hints that the allies might provide arms to the rebels. Intense negotiation reportedly is going on behind the scenes to find a country that would agree to give safe haven to Libya's dictator.

◆ There are fears of contaminated seafood due to radiation in the waters off Japan's coast near its troubled nuclear plant. Meantime, the president of the company that operates the plant has been admitted to a Tokyo hospital after suffering dizziness and high blood pressure.

◆ President Obama has outlined a goal of reducing U.S. oil imports by one-third by the year 2025. He says he will boost domestic oil production, increase the use of biofuels and natural gas, and make vehicles more energy efficient.

◆ Employers added more than 200,000 jobs in March and the number of planned layoffs fell. Prices climbed on Wall Street. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,350.61; up 71.60.

◆ The FDA is examining a possible link between dyes found in everyday food and hyperactivity in children.
