## STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

### ◆ POLICE SEEK ROBBERY SUSPECT

The Athens Police Department is asking for your help in identifying the female robber who held up the Walgreen's Pharmacy on Congress Parkway around 6:15 p.m. Monday. The woman handed the pharmacy clerk a note demanding narcotics. She pulled up her shirt to show a black handgun in her waistband. The pharmacist put an undisclosed amount of oxycontin and morphine in a bag and the suspect left on foot. The store's surveillance camera took a picture of the suspect at the entrance. To the right is a photo of the possible getaway car. If you can identify her, please call the Athens Police Department at 744-2730.



## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Japan is ranking its nuclear crisis at the highest possible severity on an international scale. That puts the Japanese crisis at the same level as the 1986 Chernobyl disaster. Meanwhile, the Japanese say the radiation leaks are declining at its crippled nuclear plant.
- ◆ President Obama will specify his proposals for reducing the nation's deficit in a speech tomorrow. Details of Obama's plan are being closely held so far, but he is expected to acknowledge a need to cut spending on Medicare and Medicaid while at the same time calling for increased taxes on the wealthy.
- ◆ U.S. stocks slid on Tuesday as oil prices dropped 3%. Goldman Sachs shook the oil markets for a second day with predictions of a drop of almost \$20 in the price of crude oil in the coming months. The Dow Jones industrial average closed down 117.53 at 12,263.58.
- ◆ Investigators have impounded an Air France A380 which collided with a Comair regional jet on a taxi-way at New York's JFK Airport on Monday. A wing of the Airbus hit the tail section of the regional jet. No one was injured.
- ◆ With the lockout at one month and counting, attorneys for NFL players sat down Tuesday with the federal magistrate who will oversee court-ordered mediation with the league later this week.
