State & Local News

◆ CONTRABAND FOUND IN SCHOOL SEARCH

The McMinn County Sheriff's office conducted a lockdown at McMinn Central High School on Thursday. While students remained in classrooms, a search of lockers was conducted with K-9 officers. Sheriff Joe Guy says several boxes of contraband were found, including a large amount of tobacco products, prescription and non-prescription medications, and several small bags of marijuana. Several beers were found in two vehicles after the students disclosed the information to the officers. Sheriff Guy says additional lockdowns will be held at both of the county's high schools.

◆ TRUCKER DIES IN I-75 CRASH

Northbound traffic on I-75 in McMinn County was blocked for several hours Thursday morning after a tractor-trailer rig ran into the rear of another truck at mile marker 50. The collision spilled chicken feed all over the highway. James Crittenden, 42, of Birchwood, TN, was killed. His truck was hauling medical waste. The driver of the other truck, Phillip Coward of Detroit, was injured. Trooper Cameron Azbill says Crittenden's truck was going 85 miles per hour when it rear-ended the other truck, which was traveling between 40 and 45 mph with hazard lights on. The northbound lanes were closed from exit 49 to exit 52 for about five hours.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Japan has officially sealed-off a wide area around their crippled nuclear power plant to stop tens of thousands of evacuated residents from sneaking back to their homes.

◆ A seriously ill 73-year-old British cruise ship passenger remains hospitalized after being accidentally dropped into the bitterly cold Norwegian Sea last month by rescue workers taking her off the ship to a hospital. Janet Richardson spent four minutes treading water after Norwegian coast guard officers let her stretcher slip into the sea.

◆ Self-made millionaire, tri-athlete, and former two-term New Mexico Governor Gary Johnson says he will seek the Republican nomination for President in 2012.

◆ Two 14-year-old Minnesota girls who felt bullied by their peers killed themselves in an apparent suicide pact during a sleepover at one of the teen's homes. The girls hanged themselves and left suicide notes.
