STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

◆ 3 TORNADOES CONFIRMED IN McMINN CO.

The National Weather Service has confirmed that three tornadoes touched down in McMinn County last Wednesday night. The first was an EF-0 tornado near Etowah at 6 p.m. The path was 2.3 miles long. The second was an EF-0 tornado that touched down at 6:38 p.m. near Reagan with a path .10 mile long. The third, and strongest, was an EF-4 tornado that touched down at 7:50 p.m. in the county Road 750 area with an 8-mile-long path from Luskville to Piney Grove. EF-0 tornadoes have winds of 65 to 85 miles per hour. EF-4 twisters have winds of 168 to 199 miles per hour.

◆ NEIGHBORS HELP NEIGHBORS

Neighbors and churches have pitched-in to help the people in the Piney Grove and Claxton communities whose homes were damaged or destroyed by the tornado. Harold and Alice Turner live at County Road 655 and CR 750. The tornado ripped the roof off their house (shown below) and destroyed 38 trees in their yard. They say members of their church, First Baptist of Athens, and neighbors in the community came to their assistance, putting a tarp on the roof and moving their furniture into storage units. The Englewood Fire Department cut up trees that had blown down. A friend gave them a house to live in until theirs is repaired.



NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ The world's public enemy number one has been taken out. An elite crew of Navy SEALs killed Osama bin Laden during a daring raid on Sunday night. It ended the world's most intense man-hunt. The September 11th mastermind was killed after he and his bodyguards resisted an assault on his secret hideout in Pakistan. His body was buried in the North Arabian Sea.

◆ The U.S. State Department warns Americans worldwide to limit travel outside of their homes and hotels and to avoid mass gatherings and demonstrations due to the increased potential for anti-American violence following the death of bin Laden.

◆ Financial markets were slightly down even at the news of Osama bin Laden's death. Crude oil fell 80¢ and gold fell \$17.20. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,807.36; down 3.18.

◆ A report out Monday says a record low one in four teenagers will be able to land a summer job this year as a result of a still poor job market.

◆ Chrysler has reported its first quarterly net profit since emerging from bankruptcy nearly two years ago.

◆ Television's "Judge Judy" has signed a new contract which will allow her to keep her hand firmly on the gavel through 2015.

Robbers Target Athens Stores

The Athens Police Department is investigating two armed robberies that occurred within a one-hour period Monday morning. The first took place at the Jiffy Mart on Eastanallee Avenue around 5:30 a.m. The clerk says as she unlocked the door, she noticed something move by the corner of the store. She hurried inside and locked the door behind her, just as a male ran up to the door with a handgun. The clerk called police and the man fled empty-handed. About 45-minutes later, a male armed with a small semi-automatic gun walked into the Valley Mart at West Madison Avenue and Cook Drive and demanded money. The clerk gave him the money from the cash register. The robber then went behind the counter and took the money bag and some rolls of coins. He left with about \$300 in cash.
