## Community News You Can Use

- ✓ Tennessee Wesleyan College will hold its 154th Commencement Exercises this Saturday at 9 a.m. in Nocatula Gardens. The Rev. Dennie Humphreys (right), senior pastor at Keith Memorial United Methodist Church, is this year's Commencement speaker. The Baccalaureate service will take place Friday at 8 p.m. in Townsend Hall. The speaker will be the Rev. Dr. Sam Roberts, Chairman of the TWC Department of Religion and Philosophy.
- ✓ Registration for kindergarten at City Park and Ingleside Schools will be this Friday, May 6. To be eligible, your child must be 5 years old on or before September 30th. You will need a copy of your child's certified birth certificate, Social Security card, immunization records, and two current proofs of residency such as a phone bill or utility bill. You must bring your child with you.
- ✓ Athens Junior High School will sponsor a 5K race this Saturday at 8 a.m. starting at the school. Proceeds benefit ALS, commonly known as Lou Gehrig's disease. Register at 7 a.m.



## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ President Obama says the White House will not release a photo of Osama bin Laden's body. Officials say the photo was gruesome and could be inflammatory.
- ◆ The Obama administration is vigorously defending the killing of the unarmed bin Laden. Attorney General Eric Holder says it was justified as "an act of national self-defense." Holder says bin Laden was killed because he made no attempt to surrender.
- ◆ President Obama's job approval rating jumped 11 points to 57% after the killing of bin Laden. But polls show that 60% of Americans fear another attack. The bump in Obama's ratings may not last. President George W. Bush received an 8-point boost after the capture of Saddam Hussein in Iraq in 2003, but that bounce evaporated within a month.
- ◆ The Navy SEALs who killed bin Laden recovered computers, hard drives, and thumb drives from his hideout. Intelligence officials hope they will provide useful information about al Qaeda.
- ◆ A new poll shows nearly 60% of Americans would never support a Republican presidential bid by former Alaska Governor Sarah Palin or reality TV star Donald Trump. However, the Quinnipiac University poll found that about half of the voters would back former governors Mitt Romney or Mike Huckabee.
