Community News You Can Use

◆ McMINN FEMA CENTER NOW OPEN

FEMA's disaster assistance center is now up and running at the Claxton Fire Hall on County Road 750 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Any resident who suffered storm-related damage is urged to visit and see if they qualify for a federal grant. You should bring your Social Security card, insurance information, documentation of your household income, and a description of your loss. McMinn County residents are eligible for up to \$29,900 in grant money, which does not have to be repaid and is not reported to the IRS as income.

◆ SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS

Now that warm weather is here, the City of Athens reminds folks with swimming pools that the pool area must be protected by a wall or fence at least five feet high and pools must be equipped with a "pool alarm" which emits a loud sound when a person or object weighing 15 pounds or more enters the water. The regulations apply to any pool containing water over 36 inches deep, including in-ground, above-ground pools and hot tubs.

REMINDER: The U.S. 11 "Antique Alley" Yard Sale gets underway today and continues through Sunday. The yard sale runs 502 miles from Meridian, Mississippi, to Bristol, Virginia.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ President Obama's approval rating has hit its highest point in two years, 60%. The AP-Gfk poll was taken after Navy Seals killed Osama bin Laden.

◆ Libyan rebels captured the Misrata airport on Wednesday after a fierce battle with Moamar Qadhafi's troops, marking their first significant advance in weeks.

◆ A federal prosecutor told a judge that a Yemeni yelled "God is Great" in Arabic as he tried to barge into the cockpit of an American Airlines flight bound from Chicago to San Francisco. He rammed his shoulder into the door until a flight attendant and several passengers subdued him. He's charged with interfering with a flight crew.

◆ The Postal Service continues to hemorrhage money, reporting a loss of over \$2 billion for the first three months of the year. Postal officials warn they might have to default on certain payments to the federal government, such as money for a trust fund to provide health care benefits for future retirees.

◆ The Presbyterian Church (USA) has voted to allow the ordination of gays as clergy, elders, and deacons.

◆ The head of cigarette maker Philip Morris told a shareholders meeting that while smoking is harmful, it is not that hard to quit.
