## STATE & LOCAL NEWS

### ◆ FEMA CENTER LISTS NEW HOURS

The FEMA Disaster Recovery Center at the Claxton Fire Hall will have new hours beginning next week. The center will be open 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. through this Saturday. It will be closed on Sunday. The new hours beginning Monday will be 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday. FEMA says there have been 101 applicants from McMinn County so far.

### ◆ ATHENS CITY COUNCIL TID-BITS

At the Athens City Council's monthly meeting this past Tuesday, the council passed the budget for the next fiscal year on the first of two readings. The budget includes no tax increases and no employee layoffs. Police Chief Chuck Ziegler reported there were 5 robberies during April, 63 thefts, 13 burglaries, 35 assaults, and 5 sex offenses. The Athens Fire Department responded to 49 calls in April, including two commercial fires. Total losses were \$115,900.

### ◆ FIRST LADY TO VISIT ETOWAH

First Lady Crissy Haslam will visit Etowah City School next Tuesday, May 24th, as part of her efforts to promote literacy. She will tour the school and read a book to second-grade students. Etowah is on the list of Tennessee's 10 Schools of Promise.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A grand jury has indicted former International Monetary Fund leader Dominique Strauss-Kahn on 7 counts in connection with the attempted rape of a New York City hotel maid. He was released on \$1 million bail and has to surrender his passport.

◆ President Obama meets with Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu today, a day after Obama called for Israel to withdraw to its borders that existed before the Six Day War in 1967.

◆ Al Qaeda has released a posthumous audio recording by Osama bin Laden in which he praised the revolutions sweeping through several Arab countries and called for more Muslim "tyrants" to be toppled.

◆ The head of the NATO military alliance says military and political pressure are weakening Moammar Gaddafi's hold on power in Libya and will eventually topple him.

◆ Government forecasters say the 2011 Atlantic hurricane season will be "above normal," with six to 10 hurricanes. They say about half of them could become major storms.

◆ The Tennessee General Assembly has delayed until next year a bill that tries to force Amazon.com to collect sales taxes on purchases made in Tennessee through the Amazon distribution centers scheduled to open later this year in Bradley and Hamilton counties.
