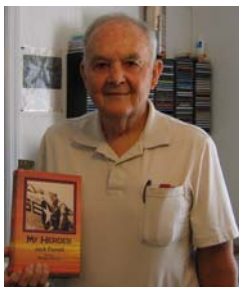
### State & Local News

#### ◆ WATTS BAR REACTOR TRIPS OFFLINE

The Unit One reactor at TVA's Watts Bar Nuclear Plant tripped offline this past Sunday due to a problem with a circuit board in a newly-installed computer system. The reactor automatically shut down when it received a malfunction signal from the turbine. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission says all systems functioned as designed with the exception of pressurized backup heaters. The reactor was restarted on Tuesday.

#### ◆ LOCAL PILOT REMEMBERS HIS "HEROES"

Jack Ferrell, retired Navy Commander and United Airlines pilot, has written an autobiography called "My Heroes." The book tells Ferrell's life story from boyhood in Oklahoma to a Navy pilot aboard an aircraft carrier during the Korean War, to a DC-10 pilot for United, finishing with his move to Athens over 30 years ago. It also tells about eight people who made a difference in his life. He will sign copies of his book on June 10th at E.G. Fisher Library. The book was edited by his daughter, Megan Burns.



### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Officials say everyone who had been reported missing since last week's massive tornado in Joplin, Missouri, has been accounted for and the 134 confirmed dead have all been identified.

◆ Fighter jets escorted a United Airlines plane back to Dulles International Airport near Washington after a fight broke out between two passengers on the flight bound for Ghana. Police met the two passengers at the gate, but they were not arrested.

◆ Stocks skidded on Wednesday after a report that companies hired fewer workers than expected in May. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,290.14; down 279.65 points.

◆ Colorado State University forecasters predict there will be 16 tropical storms during the Atlantic hurricane season that began Wednesday, with nine growing into hurricanes.

◆ Retired pilot Chesley "Sully" Sullenberger has a new job. Sullenberger, who became a national hero two years ago when he landed a crippled US Airways jet in the Hudson River, is now the on-air aviation and safety expert for CBS News.

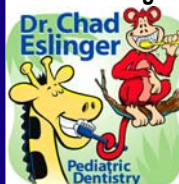
