◆ FIRE DESTROYS CAR ON CR 500

A 1999 Chevy Metro owned by James Tyler was destroyed and a pickup truck owned by Darrell Moses suffered moderate damage in a fire at 263 County Road 500 this past Friday afternoon. Witnesses said the fire started at the rear of the car near the fuel tanks. The Etowah and Englewood Rural Fire Departments responded.



◆ TRUCK HITS PARKED CAR IN ETOWAH

There were no injuries in a collision at the intersection of Pennsylvania Avenue and 6th Street in Etowah Saturday afternoon. The 2008 Grand Prix was parked in front of the Boy Scout building when it was run over by the bucket truck owned by Ward's Tree Service.

WORLD & NATIONAL NEWS

◆ Pakistani authorities say they are almost certain that a recent U.S. missile strike killed one of the most wanted leaders of al-Qaida. However, the lack of a body leaves some room for doubt.

◆ Protesters danced, sang, and slaughtered cows in the central square of Yemen's capital on Sunday to celebrate the departure of the nation's leader for medical treatment in Saudi Arabia. He was wounded in a rocket attack on his compound.

◆ U.S. Defense Secretary Robert Gates expressed his concerns about pulling troops out of Afghanistan too soon as he began two days of farewell visits to remote U.S. bases in the country.

◆ Israeli troops opened fire Sunday on a crowd of pro-Palestinian protesters who tried to break into the Israeli-controlled Golan Heights from neighboring Syria. Six people were killed and dozens were wounded. Israel accuses the Syrian regime of orchestrating the violence in an effort to deflect attention from its own bloody crackdown on uprisings at home.

◆ The US Airways plane that made a splash-landing in the Hudson River more than two years ago has begun a road trip to Charlotte, North Carolina, where it will become a permanent exhibit at the Carolinas Aviation Museum. The Airbus A320 airplane has sat in a New Jersey warehouse since it was pulled from the Hudson River after the January 2009 landing. All 155 aboard survived. Pilot "Sully" Sullenberger became an American hero for his quick-thinking decision to land in the river after the plane struck a flock of birds just after take-off from New York's Laganardia Airport and lost power in both engines.
