- ◆ Scandal-scarred New York Rep. Anthony Weiner is clinging to his job in Congress despite increasing calls by fellow Democrats to resign, a new x-rated photo of Weiner that turned up on the Internet, and news that his wife is pregnant.
- ◆ Alabama's governor has signed the nation's toughest law cracking down on illegal immigration. Among other things, the law requires public schools to determine a student's immigration status, makes it a crime to knowingly give an illegal immigrant a ride, and allows police to arrest anyone suspected of being an illegal immigrant if they are stopped for any other reason.
- ◆ A lightning strike at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, sent 77 Air Force Reserve cadets to the hospital. Two cadets were transported by ambulance and the rest by bus after a bolt struck during a severe thunderstorm. Officials say all were responsive and in stable condition.
- ◆ The International Criminal Court accuses Libya's Moammar Gadhafi of giving Viagra to his army and ordering them to rape women who were against the government. Some of the women have fled to Tunisia, where they sought abortions.
