#### ◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The nation's top military officer, Navy Admiral Mike Mullen, has told Congress that President Obama's decision to withdraw up to 33,000 troops from Afghanistan by next summer is risky, but keeps the U.S. on a path toward stabilizing the country. House Minority Leader Nancy Pelosi says she hoped the full drawdown of U.S. forces would happen sooner than the president's schedule. Republican Sen. John McCain says the drawdown is too rash.
- ◆ Oil prices crashed more than \$8 to a four-month low on Thursday after the world's consumer nations said they would release emergency oil reserves in an attempt to aid the global economy. President Obama says the U.S. will release 30 million barrels of oil reserves.
- ◆ Stocks slid again Thursday in the wake of a sharp drop in oil prices. The Dow Jones industrial average closed at 12,050.00; down 59.67 points.
- ◆ The No. 1 person on the FBI's Ten Most Wanted list has been caught. Boston mob boss James "Whitey" Bulger, 81, was captured at an apartment in California without incident.
- ◆ Parkridge Medical Center in Chattanooga will have to pay the cost of digging up the coffin of a patient because hospital staff members mistakenly put his hospital roommate's dentures in the coffin with him. Parkridge apologized to both families.

### THIS DAY IN HISTORY - JUNE 24

**1541** - Spanish conquistador Francisco de Orellana, the first European to sail down Brazil's Amazon River, fought a famous battle with warrior women. The women were described as tall with long braided hair wound around their heads. They resembled the fighting women of ancient Greek legend, the Amazons, so much that the river where the battle took place has been called the Amazon ever since.

**1895** - Heavyweight boxing champ Jack Demsey was born.

**1948** - Russia blockaded the western zones of Berlin, obstructing all rail, water, and highway routes. This set the stage for the "Berlin Airlift," in which the Western allies flew in supplies to meet the needs of more than 2-million people in West Berlin.

**1975** - An Eastern Airlines Boeing 727 crashed at New York's Kennedy International Airport, killing 114.
