## State & Local News

### ◆ ANOTHER SMALL QUAKE IN ATHENS AREA

The U.S. Geological Survey reports another small earthquake occurred near Athens earlier this week. The tremor measured 1.7 on the Richter Scale and was centered about halfway between Athens and Calhoun. It occurred at 10:10 p.m. this past Sunday, June 26th. It's the latest in a series of minor earthquakes that occur each year along a fault line that runs through Southeast Tennessee.

### ◆ PLEASE DON'T BLOCK THE VIEW !!

The Athens Community Development Department reminds all residents about the city ordinance regulating trees, fences, etc., which obstruct the view of motorists at intersections. Property owners must maintain their fencing, trees, hedges, etc., so that motorists on the public streets or alleys can obtain a clear view of traffic when approaching an intersection. The obstructions listed above are to be no more than two feet in height and are not allowed within 50 feet of the center line of any street.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ President Obama insists that limiting tax breaks for oil companies, owners of private jets, and the super-wealthy must be part of any deficit reduction plan. The President also is calling on lawmakers to renew a payroll tax cut that took place on January 1st.

◆ Reports say former University of Tennessee quarterback Heath Shuler is a candidate for UT's vacant athletics director job. Shuler, now a North Carolina congressman, reportedly has been approached about the job and is considering it.

◆ Stock prices rose for the third straight day. The Dow Jones Industrial average closed at 12,261.42; up 72.73 points.

◆ A federal appeals court in Cincinnati has upheld President Obama's health care overhaul. It was the first by a federal appeals court on the health overhaul. More than 30 legal challenges have been filed, and the case is expected to reach the U.S. Supreme Court.

◆ International officials have confirmed that an attack by suicide bombers on a hotel in Afghanistan that left 19 dead was the work of a Pakistan-based terrorist group closely allied with the Taliban.

◆ Veterans in Houston say the Department of Veterans Affairs is censoring their prayers by banning them from saying the words "God" and "Jesus" during funerals at Houston National Cemetery.

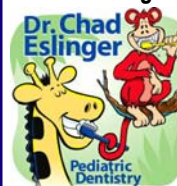

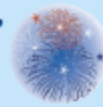
