## STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

### ◆ THREE AIRLIFTED FROM POLK CRASH

Three people are hospitalized at Erlanger after a pickup truck wreck in Polk County off Highway 315. Authorities say the truck wrecked, throwing a man out of the truck bed and running over him. The other two occupants picked him up and loaded him back into the bed, and drove off. They wrecked again a short distance away. An Air Evac helicopter struck a power line after taking off with the first patient and had to make a "hard" emergency landing. ## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The Senate on Tuesday passed emergency legislation to allow the government to borrow more money after House passage Monday evening. The Senate vote was 74 to 26. Senator Lamar Alexander voted for the bill, calling it a change in behavior from "Spend, spend, spend to Cut, cut, cut." President Obama signed the agreement Tuesday afternoon.

◆ Despite the debt legislation, the Dow Jones industrial average fell for the 8th straight day after the Commerce Department reported that consumers cut spending in June by the biggest amount in two years. The Dow Jones industrial average closed at 11,866.62; down 265.87 points.

◆ The Centers for Disease Control reports one person has died from salmonella poisoning that appears to be linked to eating ground turkey. Seventy-six people in 26 states have become ill.

### MORE LOCAL NEWS

- The McMinn County Commission has passed the budget for the new fiscal year. It does not contain any new tax increases, but shifts \$847,000 in capital funds earmarked for expansion of the Justice Center into the general fund.

- Curtis Jordan III has been arraigned in McMinn County Court on charges of murdering his father, Curtis Jordan II, in 2010.

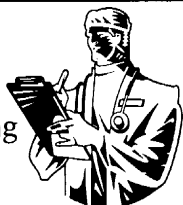
