### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A Russian jet carrying a popular ice hockey team crashed just after takeoff from an airport 150 miles northeast of Moscow on Wednesday. The crash killed 43 people. It was one of the worst plane crashes ever involving a sports team in Russia.
- ◆ President Obama will outline his job-creating package in a speech to Congress tonight. Sources say he will unveil a plan to inject more than \$300 billion into the economy next year through tax cuts, spending on infrastructure, and aid to state and local governments. The price of the proposed package would be offset by spending cuts.
- ◆ U.S. stocks rallied on Wednesday, reversing three days of losses on hopes the European debt crisis might ease after Germany's top court smoothed the way for Berlin's participation in bailout packages. The Dow Jones Average closed up 275.56 at 11,414.86.
- ◆ Michigan Governor Rick Snyder has signed into law a strict four-year lifetime limit on cash welfare benefits. Exemptions will be offered to those with a disability who can't work, those who care for a disabled spouse or child, and those over 65 who don't qualify for Social Security benefits. Snyder says the intent of the law is to return cash welfare to its original intent as a transitional program to help people while they work toward self-sufficiency.
