◆ NATIONAL CHAMPS COMING TO ATHENS

The Athens Area Chamber of Commerce has announced that former Tennessee Football Coach Phillip Fulmer, Quarterback Tee Martin, & Team Captain Al Wilson will be the guest speakers at the Chamber's annual benefit banquet here in Athens. Martin and Wilson played on Tennessee's National Championship Team of 1998. The date of the event will be either July 14 or July 21st of next year. Currently Coach Fulmer is a sports analyst, Tee Martin is an assistant football coach at Kentucky, & Al Wilson is retired from playing in the NFL for the Denver Broncos.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Libyan leader Moammar Gadhafi died today as his hometown fell to the one-time rebels who ousted him, ending the last vestiges of control for the man once hailed as the "king of kings of Africa." Gadhafi tried to flee his hometown of Sirte in a convoy, but French fighter jets prevented his escape. Video of rebels leading a bloodied Gadhafi away were shown on Arab TV. A rebel spokesman said that Gadhafi bled to death, other reports said that rebels shot him to death, ending his 42 years of brutal rule.



◆ Greek protesters rampaged outside parliament with firebombs and stones, leaving one construction worker dead, as lawmakers inside gathered to vote on deeply unpopular new cutbacks demanded by international creditors.

◆ The number of Americans who bought previously occupied homes fell in September. Home sales are on pace to match last year's dismal figures; the worst in 13 years.

◆ Libya's information minister says Moammar Gadhafi's son Muatassim was also killed in Sirte.
