- ◆ Israeli President Shimon Peres warns that an attack by Israel on Iranian nuclear facilities is becoming increasingly likely.
- ◆ CBS commentator Andy Rooney has died at age 92 following major complications from recent surgery.
- ◆ Singer Andy Williams says he has bladder cancer. Williams, who is 83, vows to get through it and continue his career.
- ◆ Evangelist Billy Graham turns 93 today. In his new book, "Nearing Home," Graham says "we were never meant for this world alone. We were meant for Heaven, our final home." Graham says he wants to preach one last sermon before he dies.

FOOTBALL: The season is over for both the McMinn Cherokees and the Meigs County Tigers. The Cherokees lost to Oak Ridge, 36-6, in the opening Class 6A playoff game...and Meigs County lost to Bledsoe County, 44-25, in the Class 3A playoffs. THIS DAY IN HISTORY - NOVEMBER 7

1665 - The world's first newspaper was published. England's King Charles and his court were hiding in Oxford from the Great Plague. They were bored and were not getting much news of outside events. So, a man named Henry Muddiman wrote a journal for them and the newspaper was born.

1914 - Country comedian Archie Campbell was born. He was a fixture for years on the Grand Ole Opry and on Hee Haw.

1918 - Evangelist Billy Graham was born on a farm near Charlotte, North Carolina. He led crusades world-wide and began a radio program called "The Hour of Decision."

2000 - Republican George W. Bush was elected president over incumbent Democrat Vice President Al Gore, though Gore won the popular vote by a narrow margin. The winner was not known for more than a month because of a dispute over the results in Florida.
