## Local & State News

### ◆ NATIONWIDE EAS TEST SET FOR TODAY

The Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Communications Commission will conduct the first ever nationwide test of the Emergency Alert System at 2 p.m. today. All radio and TV stations will be interrupted for a test which will last approximately 30 seconds. The purpose of the test is to determine how well the EAS system would perform its primary function: alerting the public about a national emergency. EAS and its predecessors--Conelrad and the EBS--have been in existence for more than 50 years. Local radio and TV stations have used the system for years to relay severe weather warnings from the National Weather Service. However, there has never been a nationwide test.

## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ Herman Cain denies allegations of his latest accuser, Sharon Bialek, claiming that he doesn't know her and that the alleged incident never happened.

◆ Italy's Premier Berlusconi promises to resign after parliament passes economic reforms demanded by the European Union. His resignation would cap a two-decade political career that has ended with Italy on the brink of being swept into Europe's debt crisis. On Wall Street, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 101.79 at 12,170.18.

◆ The future of Penn State football coach Joe Paterno is up in the air. The school's president abruptly canceled Paterno's weekly news conference Tuesday amid calls for his resignation in the wake of former defensive coordinator Jerry Sandusky's sex-abuse scandal.

◆ Readers of "Radio Ink" magazine have chosen Dick Biondi as the Top DJ of the 1960s. Biondi was a night-time disc jockey at WLS in Chicago in the early 1960s. WLS is a 50,000 watt AM station that covers much of the nation at night. During his heyday, he had 60 percent of the national radio audience at night. He was the first DJ in America to play the Beatles. Today, at the age of 79, he's still on the air in Chicago.
