## Local & State News

### ◆ NIOTA MAN HEADED TO FEDERAL PRISON

A former operator at the Niota sewage treatment plant has been sentenced to six months in federal prison for falsifying documents about discharges from the plant. Prosecutors say Donald Jack Clark, 58, failed to properly disinfect waste water before it was discharged into the Little North Mouse Creek and tried to cover it up by making false documents. Prosecutors say he potentially put the public at risk of contracting serious illness. Clark had been a licensed wastewater treatment plant operator for 14 years. After six months in prison, Clark will have to serve six months on home detention and perform 150 hours of community service.

### ◆ MAYFIELD NAMES CAMPAIGN MANAGER

Scottie Mayfield says Bo Patton of Chattanooga will be his campaign manager for his run for Congress from the Third District. Mayfield says he will likely wait to make his formal announcement that he is running until he opens a campaign office in Chattanooga. Mayfield filed papers to run last week. It will be his first venture into politics. Mayfield will run as a Republican, against Congressman Chuck Fleischmann, Weston Wamp, and at least two other Republicans.

## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ It was a clean sweep for Rick Santorum. He won the nominating contests in Missouri, Minnesota, and Colorado Tuesday night. He now has four victories under his belt, more than any other republican candidate.

◆ A federal appeals court has declared California's voter-approved same-sex marriage ban to be unconstitutional, paving the way for a likely U.S. Supreme Court showdown on the law.

◆ One million people lined the streets in New York City Tuesday as New York celebrated its team's Super Bowl victory with a ticker-tape parade. The New York Giants football players were showered with confetti along the Canyon of Heroes in lower Manhattan.

◆ An Australian, Felix Baumgartner, plans to skydive from a balloon at an altitude of 120,000 feet this August. If he succeeds, he'll become the first person to break the sound barrier outside of an aircraft. His plunge would also mark the highest skydive, the highest manned balloon flight, and the longest free fall.

◆ Before Monica Lewinsky, there was Mimi Alford. The 68-year-old one-time White House intern has written a book detailing her affair with President John F. Kennedy in 1962. She says the 18-month affair ended shortly before Kennedy was assassinated.
