State & Local News

◆ ETOWAH'S WATER WINS TASTE TEST

It's safe to drink the water in Etowah. In fact, you'll enjoy the taste. In a competition conducted by the Tennessee Association of Utility Districts, the judges said Etowah's water tastes better than any other water in Southeast Tennessee. Etowah's water went up against water from the Athens Utilities Board, the Hixson Utility District, and the Ocoee Utility District. Etowah's water will now be entered into a state-wide competition to be held in August.

◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

✓ The dates for the annual Clean Up Week in Athens will be April 16-20. You can place your junk and rubbish at the curbside and the Public Works Department will pick it up sometime that week. Crews will NOT accept gas tanks from vehicles or cooking grills. Tires must be removed from the rims. Compressor/coolant lines must be removed from appliances.

✓ The McMinn County Board of Education will hold a Work Session at 5 p.m. today at the Central Office to discuss procedures and a timeline for selecting a Director of Schools. The board will take a short break after the workshop and then hold a called meeting. Joe Gaston and Mickey Blevins are the two applicants.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ At least 13 people were killed when a powerful storm system produced multiple tornadoes across the Midwest early Wednesday. A twister tore through Branson, Missouri, ripping roofs off hotels and damaging some of the city's famed music theaters. More than 30 people were injured in Branson. At least six people were killed in Harrisburg, Illinois, when a storm leveled much of the community of 9,000 people. One person died in Cumberland County, TN.

◆ Mitt Romney and Rick Santorum are looking ahead to Super Tuesday now that Michigan and Arizona are behind them. The two candidates each won 15 delegates in the Michigan primary. Santorum campaigned in Knoxville yesterday.

◆ The U.S. says North Korea has agreed to allow the return of nuclear inspectors and has agreed to implement a moratorium on long-range missile tests and nuclear tests. In return, the U.S. will provide North Korea with a large food aid package.

◆ Davy Jones, the lead singer of the pop group The Monkees, has died at the age of 66 after suffering a heart attack in Florida. The group had such hit records as "Daydream Believer" and "Last Train to Clarksville."

◆ The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 53.05 at 12,952.07.

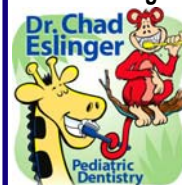
