State & Local News

◆ REP. FLEISCHMANN TO VISIT ATHENS

Third District Congressman Chuck Fleischmann has started a summer-long tour to discuss his voting record with voters of the newly-drawn district. His tour comes to Athens tomorrow, May 2nd, with a stop at the McMinn County Courthouse at 6:30 p.m. He will meet with voters in the Blue Room.

◆ AUB TO UPGRADE VETERAN'S PARK PIPES

AUB will begin a three-month construction project today that will upgrade wastewater lines that run underground through Veteran's Park along Oostanaula Creek in downtown Athens. While the work is taking place, the park-all or sections of it-will be off limits for public use from time to time.

◆ CHAMBER SCHEDULES NEXT CASH MOB

The Athens Chamber of Commerce has scheduled its 2nd cash mob for Thursday, May 3rd, at 11:15 a.m. at Pam's 2-Step and Sir-Lamps-A-Lot at 106 North White Street in downtown Athens. The first cash mob brought 45 people to the Outdoor Store. Chamber CEO Rob Preston says the mob will gather at 11:10 a.m. outside Pam's 2-Step. The idea is for each person to make a purchase and show their support for another locally owned business.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Relatives say the SUV that plunged more than 50 feet from the Bronx River Parkway on Sunday, killing seven people from three generations of a Bronx family, was headed to a family reunion. The dead ranged in age from 3 to 85.

◆ The wife of an ex-aide to John Edwards testified Monday that the former presidential candidate told her over the phone that it was legal to take money from a wealthy donor to "take care" of Edwards' mistress. Cheri Young said she had doubts about taking the money and insisted on speaking to Edwards about whether it was legal.

◆ Al Armedariz, the Environmental Protection Agency official who said in a 2010 video that the EPA should "crucify" polluters has resigned. He expressed regret for his comments.

◆ Police say two teenage girls are hospitalized in fair condition after they fell asleep while sunbathing on a rural Pennsylvania road and were struck by a car.

◆ Scientists have identified a gene that slows the spread of pancreatic cancer tumors, paving the way for targeted treatment of one of the deadliest forms of the disease.

◆ The Mid-East Tennessee Regional Fair at the Athens Regional Park has been cancelled for this year. No reason has been given.
