◆ Former White House candidate Newt Gingrich says Mitt Romney has "earned the right to represent the Republican Party" against President Barack Obama and that he'll help Romney's campaign in any way he can.

◆ Republican Sen. Marco Rubio of Florida deflected questions about the vice presidency in an interview Sunday morning and instead zeroed in on the failings of President Obama and the spark he's lost since 2008.

◆ The FBI is working to identify two people found dead at a home in Mississippi associated with a man suspected in the abduction of a woman and her three daughters from Hardeman County, Tennessee, about 70 miles east of Memphis. An Amber Alert has been issued for Jo Ann Bain and her daughters, Kylivah, 8, Alexandria, 12, and Adrienne, 14. They are believed to have been abducted by 35-year-old Adam Mayes.

◆ "I'll Have Another" won the 138th Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs before a record crowd of more than 165,000 in Louisville, Kentucky, on Saturday.

◆ Danish researchers have found that people who jog at least an hour a week live an average of six years longer than non-joggers.
