Local & State News

◆ ROBBERS NABBED IN SEVIER COUNTY

Christopher James Henley, 19, has been arrested for robbery at the Athens Wal-Mart. Henley, along with a male juvenile, entered the store around 3 a.m. Saturday and went through a check-out lane, where they shoved the clerk, Rena Gussie, to the floor and grabbed a handful of cash from the register and fled on foot. The two suspects were arrested for shoplifting in Gatlinburg on Monday. Henley will be transported back to McMinn County to face charges.

◆ ATHENS POLICE/FIRE MONTHLY REPORT

The Athens Police Department reports there were 71 thefts in April, 20 burglaries, 16 assaults, 3 motor vehicle thefts, 3 robberies, and 2 sex offenses. In addition, there were 78 vehicle accidents with a total of 17 injuries.

According to Fire Chief Jim Dyer, the Athens Fire Department responded to 32 calls in April. There were no financial losses and no calls to residential fires. The calls included grass fires, trash fires, vehicle accidents, five false alarms, and a variety of miscellaneous calls including EMS lift assists, oil spills, replacing smoke detector batteries, and a call after someone pulled a fire alarm station as a prank.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A flight from Paris bound for Charlotte, N.C., was diverted to Maine on Tuesday after a passenger claimed to have a device surgically implanted inside her, sparking security concerns. The woman, a French citizen from Cameroon, was arrested after the plane landed in Bangor, Maine.

◆ Across Italy police are cracking down on Ferrari and Lamborghini drivers, but not because they are driving too fast. Italy, like so much of southern Europe, is drowning in debt, so police are pursuing drivers to make sure they are declaring – and therefore paying taxes on – earnings that would allow them to afford cars worth as much as half a million dollars.

◆ Forty-one Republican Senators have challenged Majority Leader Harry Reid and insist that he begin acting now to avert "Taxmageddon" at the end of the year. Taxes will increase on Jan. 1st by \$310 Billion when the Bush-Era tax cuts expire and payroll taxes will automatically increase. Reid says it will be impossible to act on tax issues in the Senate before the November elections.

◆ A mountain lion found in the courtyard of an office building was shot and killed Tuesday after it tried to escape. Authorities are trying to figure out how the large cat made its way into downtown Santa Monica, California.

Duncan Visits WYXI RADIO

Second District Congressman John J. Duncan, Jr. was in Athens on Tuesday, to meet with constituents and the local media. Congressman Duncan will continue to represent McMinn County in the U.S. House of Representatives until the end of this year. McMinn County will be part of the 3rd Congressional District in 2013. Duncan recorded an interview at the WYXI STUDIOS and it will be broadcast tonight at 7 p.m. on AM-1390. He will review the many years that he and his late father represented our county and also summarize some of the problems facing the country.



AREA NEWS

- A Polk County man, 48-year-old Samuel Cross, died late Monday night after hitting a tractor-trailer head-on with his pickup truck. According to the THP, Cross was driving southbound on Highway 411 north of Benton, lost control of his truck, crossed the center line and hit the semi. Cross was not wearing any safety restraints. The driver of the tractor trailer was not injured.
- Three women were shot and killed at an apartment in Powell Monday afternoon. The victims were identified as Christina Moore, 39, her twin sister Bridgett Stagnolia of Anderson County, and Amber Sellings, 24, of Anderson County. Paul Moore, Jr., age 51, the husband of Christina Moore, was charged with first degree murder and held on a \$1.5 million bond. Investigators say that the motive in the killings appeared to be a domestic related argument.
- The mild winter we enjoyed is being blamed for a big rise in insect-borne diseases. The Tennessee Department of Health has identified 74 cases of Rocky Mountain spotted fever statewide; three times the rate the disease was discovered last year. People are being urged to check themselves frequently for ticks, use insecticides, and to seek medical help if they develop fever, joint pain, and a rash.
