◆ TROOPER'S GRANDCHILD DIES FROM BULLET

A three-year-old Bradley County girl, Kydalynn Robinson, has died from an accidental gunshot wound. Authorities say Kydalynn and her 2-year-old cousin were playing at a home on Benwood Trail when they found a .45 caliber handgun. The gun discharged and the bullet hit Kydalynn near her left eye. The incident occurred at the home of Kydalynn's grandfather, Tennessee Highway Patrolman, Lt. Tommie Graham.

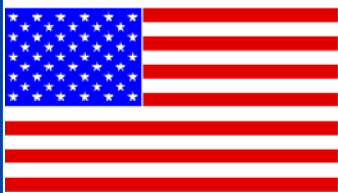
◆ A federal appeals court in Boston has declared that the Defense of Marriage Act unconstitutionally denies federal benefits to married gay couples. The court said the 1996 law that defines marriage as a union between a man and a woman deprives gay couples of the rights and privileges granted to heterosexual couples. The case is certain to advance to the U.S. Supreme Court.

◆ New York City Mayor Michael Bloomberg is proposing new rules that would prohibit restaurants, mobile food carts, and concessions at movie theaters and stadiums from selling sugary soft drinks larger than 16 ounces. Coca-Cola has fired back, saying the proposed ban on large-sized soft drinks is insulting to New Yorkers.

◆ Sen. John Edwards was found not guilty on one of six counts in a campaign-finance trial by a North Carolina jury which declared itself hopelessly deadlocked on the remaining charges, leading the judge to declare a mistrial on those counts.

◆ Authorities in upstate New York have charged a 28-year-old man with driving his motorcycle at nearly 200 mph on a highway in the rain. A state trooper radioed a description of the high-performance bike and it was eventually stopped. The driver told troopers he was headed to a hospital to visit a patient. He was issued 14 separate traffic tickets.

◆ If you can get a new mortgage or refinance an existing one, you should be able to get an unbelievably low interest rate. Interest on a 15-year loan is down to 2.97%, the lowest rate ever.
