## Local & State News

### ◆ COUNTY HEALTH RANKINGS

A national study says Grundy County is the unhealthiest county in Tennessee. The study by the University of Wisconsin looked at such factors as death rates, obesity, smoking, exercise, education, and access to health care. Rhea County ranked #86 among the state's 95 counties, Meigs County was #83, and Polk County was #77.

McMinn County ranked #55. The figures for McMinn County show 21% of adults smoke, 34% are obese, 34% are physically inactive, 23% are in poor or fair health, and 17% are uninsured.

Monroe County ranked considerably higher than most other rural counties in Southeast Tennessee. Monroe County is listed as #36 on the rankings.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Rielle Hunter says she was not John Edwards' first or only mistress. In a new tell-all memoir, Hunter reveals that Edwards, a two-time presidential candidate, had affairs with at least two other women dating back 20 years. Edwards was acquitted last month on one count of violating campaign finance rules in his trial for allegedly using campaign donations to cover up his illicit affair.

◆ A Taliban leader in Pakistan says until the United States stops drone strikes, it will ban polio vaccinations of Pakistani children in the regions it controls.

◆ Stocks were mixed on Monday as investors were concerned about the health of the global economy even though the pro-Euro party won the election in Greece. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 25.35 at 12,741.82.

◆ Safety regulators are taking a close look at 1.4 million Toyota vehicles for a possible fire risk. The probe includes the best-selling Camry sedan from model years 2007-2009. Fires have been reported at a high rate for Toyota models built from 2006 to 2008 that have the same power window master switch design.

◆ Authorities say three people in a glider have been killed when the aircraft went down in a field in Southeast Texas. The victims included a man, a woman, and a 3-year-old boy.
