◆ Time is quickly running out for Congress to pass stopgap legislation that would prevent interest rates on subsidized student loan debt from doubling to 6.8 percent July 1.

◆ A British company has cancelled insurance for a Russian-operated ship it said was carrying munitions to Syria; a shipment the British government says included refurbished military helicopters.

◆ The prospect that thousands of drones could be patrolling U.S. skies by the end of this decade is raising the specter of a Big Brother government that peers into backyards and bedrooms.

◆ Several well-known brands of baby shampoo and body wash are triggering false-positive results on marijuana exposure screening tests for infants. Soaps that were specifically associated with false-positive marijuana test results include Johnson & Johnson's Bedtime Bath, CVS Night-Time Baby Bath, Aveeno Baby Soothing Relief Creamy Wash and Aveeno Baby Wash & Shampoo.

◆ A Detroit man is facing 15 months in prison after he was able to withdraw unlimited ATM cash from his Bank of America account that only held a few dollars. Ronald Page, 55, took advantage of a bank mistake that placed his account into a "pay all" status. He withdrew over \$1.5 million and lost the money at area casinos.

An Orange a Day Keeps Stroke Away

A diet rich in citrus fruits, such as oranges and grapefruits, may reduce women's risk of stroke, a new study says.

In the study, women who ate the most citrus fruit had a 19 percent lower risk of having an ischemic stroke than women who ate the least. In an ischemic stroke, blood flow to the brain is blocked, sometimes by clogged arteries.
