## Local & State News

### ◆ MORE OVERSIZE LOADS TO MOVE ON I-75

Each night this week, more oversize loads will be moving south on I-75 at exit 49 to exit 33. The oversize loads are long tubes that are headed to the new Wacker plant in Charleston. The moves will take place Monday through Thursday nights between the hours of 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. The speed of the transport vehicle is slow, only 10 to 15 m.p.h., and will occupy both lanes of the interstate.



### ◆ SALES TAX HOLIDAY IS THIS WEEKEND

The 7th Annual Sales Tax Holiday is scheduled for this coming weekend in Tennessee. During the three-day tax holiday from 12:01a.m. Friday to 11:59 p.m. Sunday, shoppers can save almost 10% on tax-free clothing, school and art supplies, and computer purchases. Shoppers will not have to pay state or local sales tax on select clothing with a price of \$100 or less per item, school and art supplies with a price of \$100 or less per item, and computers with a price of \$1500 or less.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Prosecutors in Colorado have charged James Holmes with two dozen counts of first-degree murder and a host of other violent crimes related to the recent deadly rampage at a movie theater. Holmes appeared in court Monday wearing the same orange-red hair he had at the time of the shooting. He said only one word during the hearing, answering "yes" when asked by the judge if he agreed to waive his right to a preliminary hearing in the next 35 days.

◆ Former Vice-President Dick Cheney says President Obama has been one of the nation's weakest presidents. In an interview with ABC, Cheney said he thinks Obama is "worse than Jimmy Carter."

◆ In Florida, an Everglades tour guide who lost his hand to an alligator last month has been arrested on charges of unlawful alligator feeding. Wallace Weatherholt was leading a tour on his airboat on June 12th when the group encountered a 9-foot alligator. Passengers say he hung a fish over the side of the boat and had his hand at the water's surface when the gator attacked.

◆ First, New York Mayor Bloomberg went after sodas. Now, he's pushing hospitals to hide their baby formula behind locked doors so more new mothers will breast-feed.
