## State & Local News

### ◆ FIELD SET FOR ATHENS ELECTIONS

Six candidates have qualified to run for the two seats that will be opening on the Athens City Council. They are incumbent Ann Davis, Chuck Burris, Connie Fain-Woodcock, Steven Sherlin, C. David Derrick, and Yvonne Raper. The two top vote-getters in the Nov. 6th election will win those two seats.

Four candidates have qualified for the three seats that will be opening on the Athens City School Board. They are incumbents Chris Adams and Michael Bevins, Alf Hacker, and Charlie Senn. The three top vote-getters will win those three seats.

### ◆ REP. FLEISCHMANN VISITS ATHENS

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Floyd Lee Corkins, 28, of Herndon, Virginia, is in FBI custody and facing a charge of assault with intent to kill. Corkins was wrestled to the ground by guards after he shot a guard in the arm at the Family Research Council's office in Washington on Wednesday. Corkins had worked as a volunteer at a center for homosexuals, bisexuals, and transgender people. The Family Research Council opposes same-sex marriage and abortion.

◆ Two sheriff's deputies in Louisiana were shot to death and two others were wounded in a shootout west of New Orleans Thursday morning. Five people are in custody. The incident started when a gunman opened fire, for unknown reasons, on a deputy working an off-duty traffic detail.

◆ U.S. securities regulators have charged Jim Donnan, a former football coach at the University of Georgia and a television commentator, with running an \$80-million Ponzi scheme. The victims of the scheme included other college coaches and former players. The victims say Donnan promised them returns of 50% to 380% on their investment.

◆ Eleven people have been killed in a Black Hawk helicopter crash in southern Afghanistan, including seven U.S. soldiers.
