◆ After decades of controversy, the all-male Augusta National Golf Club has admitted its first female members, former Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice and business executive Darla Moore.

◆ The public school system in Portland, Maine, will no longer allow soft drinks to be sold on school property – including at high school football games. School officials are also banning the sale of gridiron staples like buttered popcorn and potato chips. Instead, football fans will be encouraged to chow down on baked tortilla chips, reduced fat string cheese, and hummus.

◆ On Wall Street, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 3.56 at 13,271.64.

CORRECTIONS: In Monday's Morning Fax, we reported a story about a police chase last Friday that ended in a crash on Highway 30 across from Fred's in Etowah. Our story said the McMinn County Sheriff's Office was one of the agencies involved in the chase. That is incorrect. 1936 - Basketball player Wilt "The Stilt" Chamberlain was born in Philadelphia. He stood 7 feet and 1 inch tall and dominated the record books during his career as a professional basketball player. He died in 1999.

1938 - Singer Kenny Rogers was born. His hit records include "The Gambler" and "Lucille."

1939 - Harold Reid, member of the Statler Brothers, was born.
