Local & State News

◆ DOUBLE FATALITY NEAR CHARLESTON EXIT

A chain-reaction type accident claimed the lives of two men early Monday morning at mile-marker 34 on the northbound side of I-75, just inside Bradley County. An International tractor-trailer driven by Charles Thomas Morgan, age 53, of Rutlege, struck a 2007 International Service truck driven by Nicolas S. Feller of Shandon, Ohio in the rear. Feller's truck was sitting in the left lane, in a clearly marked construction zone. Feller had exited his vehicle and was standing in front of it when the impact occurred. Morgan and Feller were both killed at the scene. The tractor trailer then struck a THP patrol car with Trooper Travis Ryans sitting inside, causing it to veer off the right side of the road. Trooper Ryans was injured and was taken to Athens Regional Medical, treated and released. Feller's body came to rest partially underneath a fourth vehicle, a Chevy Pickup, which was another service truck parked in front of Trooper Ryan's patrol car in the construction zone. Trooper Phillip Dunn's report stated that all 3 vehicles in the construction zone were stationary in the left lane with all emergency warning lights functioning normally. The wreck occurred at 3:43 a.m. and traffic was blocked about 7 hours.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ President Obama said that the Sept. 11 attack that claimed the life of the U.S. ambassador to Libya and three other Americans "wasn't just a mob action," but he stopped short of explicitly labeling the assault as an act of terrorism. Obama's comments came as he taped an interview with "The View" during a brief trip to New York to address the annual United National General Assembly.

◆ Republican vice presidential nominee Paul Ryan made a pitch to Ron Paul supporters during a rally in Lima, Ohio, on Monday. Ryan addressed a Ron Paul supporter and asked: "Do you want Barack Obama to be re-elected?" Ryan asked. "Then don't vote for Ron Paul."

◆ A Harvard-educated biologist was sentenced to life in prison without parole Monday after being convicted of going on a shooting rampage during a faculty meeting at an Alabama university, killing three colleagues and wounding three others in 2010.

◆ The Taliban published a video they say shows insurgents preparing for the brazen attack on a major NATO base earlier this month in Afghanistan.

◆ Two U.S. Marines have become the first to be criminally charged for allegedly urinating on the corpses of Taliban fighters on camera.
