#### ◆ CAR CRASH CLAIMS VONORE WOMAN

The Tennessee Highway Patrol says that Michelle Gross of Vonore died Tuesday morning on Highway 72 in Loudon County. According to the THP, Gross crossed the center line and hit a garbage truck head-on. The driver of the truck was identified as Michael Matheny of Tellico Plains. He was injured in the crash and taken to U.T. Medical Center. Both drivers were wearing safety belts at the time of the crash.

#### ◆ TWO LOUDON COUNTY OFFICERS DIE

Denero and Deacon, K-9 officers with the Loudon County Sheriff's Department, have died of cancer. Both dogs were about 9 years old and had won numerous law enforcement awards.

### World & National News

◆ Andy Williams has died at the age of 84. The iconic singer died at his home in Branson, Missouri Tuesday night after battling bladder cancer for the past year. William's signature song was "Moon River" written by Henry Mancini and Johnny Mercer and featured in the movie "Breakfast at Tiffany's". He named his showplace in Branson the "Moon River" Theater.



◆ Demonstrators have clashed with police on the streets of Athens and Madrid in an upsurge of popular anger at new austerity measures being imposed on two of the euro zone's most vulnerable economies. In some of the most violent confrontations on Wednesday, Greek police fired tear gas at hooded rioters hurling gasoline bombs as thousands joined the country's biggest protest in more than a year.

◆ According to his campaign, Wednesday marked the president's 13th visit so far this year to Ohio and his 29th since taking office.

◆ An Army brigadier general, Jeffrey Sinclair, who served five combat tours in Iraq and Afghanistan has been charged with forcible sodomy, multiple counts of adultery and having inappropriate relationships with several female subordinates.
