Local & State News

◆ ETOWAH TRYING TO BAN PIT BULLS

The Etowah City Commission has approved the first reading of an ordinance that will ban pit bulldogs inside the city limits. The proposal must pass final reading on October 22nd before it becomes law.

◆ CHAMBER PLANNING MULTIPLE CASH MOBS

The Athens Area Chamber of Commerce will have a "double" cash mob today. The first one will take place at 11:15 this morning at the Valley Farmers Co-Op on North Congress Parkway. Then at 12 noon, "mobbers" will descend on Toscano's Pizza & Italian Grill in the Ingles Shopping Center for lunch. Everyone is invited to participate and spend some cash in order to stimulate local businesses, which is the lifeblood of the community.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Former Massachusetts Governor Mitt Romney now leads President Barack Obama by 4 points in the first national poll to be conducted entirely after the opening presidential debate. Pew Research Center conducted the poll from Thursday through Sunday and shows Romney leading Obama among likely voters nationwide, 49 percent to 45 percent. Pew's mid-September poll, conducted after both conventions, showed Obama up 8 points among likely voters.

◆ An alleged drug cartel leader known as Commander Squirrel, has been arrested by Mexican authorities, who they say is linked to the 2010 murder of American jet skier David Hartley on a border lake.

◆ Local police have been enlisted by health authorities to aid in identifying more people with a rare form of meningitis who may have been infected by tainted steroid injections.

◆ According to the House Intelligence Committee, China's two leading technology firms, Huawei Technologies Ltd. and ZTE Corp pose a national security threat to the United States, and American companies should avoid sourcing network equipment from them.

◆ According to AAA, the average price of gasoline in the state of California hit \$4.668. The Federal Trade Commission has been asked to investigate by Senator Dianne Feinstein of California.
