◆ LOOKING FORWARD TO PUMPKINTOWN

The annual Pumpkintown Festival is just about here. The big event begins Saturday at 10 a.m. with opening ceremonies at the Market Park. A special recognition will be given to Congressman John J. Duncan, Jr. for representing McMinn County in the U.S. House for the past 24 years. Other activities will include historical walking tours with Sheriff Joe Guy at 11 a.m. and Patsy Duckworth at 3 p.m. The Heritage Quilt Guild Quilt Show will be at the Arts Center and the African-American Quilt Show "A Legacy of Love" will be at the TWC Sherman Fine Arts Building. World & National News

◆ In an interview broadcast on Wednesday, President Obama said that he was "just too polite" in his first debate with Mitt Romney in a new explanation for the incumbent's widely panned performance in that prime-time political bout. The President promised to be more combative during the second and third debates which will be held on October 16th and 22nd. Obama said that "We're going to take it to him."

◆ South Carolina's Voter ID law was blocked Wednesday from going into effect for the 2012 elections by a federal court in Washington, but said it could go into effect for future elections.

◆ Defense Secretary Leon Panetta said Wednesday, the United States has sent military troops to the Jordan-Syria border to bolster that country's military capabilities in the event that violence escalates along its border with Syria.

◆ Lance Armstrong challenged the U.S. Anti-Doping Agency to name names and show what it had on him. On Wednesday, it did. The anti-doping group released a report on its case against Armstrong, a point-by-point roadmap of the lengths it says Armstrong went-to in order to win seven Tour de France titles that the USADA has ordered taken away from Armstrong.

Today in History-October 11

1868 - Thomas Edison filed papers for his first invention. It was an electrical vote recorder to rapidly tabulate floor votes in the U.S. Congress. Members of Congress rejected it by a show of hands.

1884 - Eleanor Roosevelt was born. As the wife of President Franklin D. Roosevelt, she was one of America's most active First Ladies. She served as a delegate to the United Nations General Assembly and worked hard to help underprivileged people and minority groups.

1932 - Singer Dottie West was born in McMinnville, TN. She had many hit records. Her biggest hit was "Country Sunshine," which she wrote as a commercial for Coca-Cola. She was killed in a car wreck in 1991 on her way to a performance at the Grand Ole Opry.

1958 - The lunar probe Pioneer 1 was launched; it failed to go as far as planned, fell back to Earth and burned up in the atmosphere.

2002 - The Senate joined the House in approving the use of America's military might against Iraq.
