## State & Local News

### ◆ TWO CONSTRUCTION WORKERS KILLED

Work at the new Wacker Chemie Polysilicon plant in Charleston has come to a halt after two construction workers were killed. Hugo Mendoza, 45, from Buford, Georgia and Louis Ochoa, 31, from Hollywood, Florida, died after falling 140 feet from a work platform that collapsed around 10 p.m. Wednesday evening. Tennessee Safety Inspectors stopped work at the massive new plant until they could determine what caused the fatal accidents.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The United States has chosen Laurence Pope, a former U.S. ambassador to Chad and senior State Department counter-terrorism official to serve as its senior envoy in Libya following the death of Ambassador Christopher Stevens in a September 11 attack in Benghazi, the State Department said on Thursday.

◆ According to USA Cycling on Thursday, the five American cyclists who testified against Lance Armstrong have all been formally banned for six months after confessing to using performance enhancing drugs. Armstrong's lawyers describes the USADA investigation as a "witch hunt," despite him being branded a cheat by dozens of people in the sport. Armstrong, 41, maintains his innocence.

◆ Defense lawyers for Major Nidal Hasan who is accused of shooting to death 13 people at Fort Hood, Texas, in November 2009, told an Army appeals court on Thursday that his court martial judge had overstepped his authority in ordering him to appear clean shaven for trial. A prosecutor, argued before the Army Court of Criminal Appeals that the court martial judge, Colonel Gregory Gross, was empowered to maintain decorum in his courtroom. Hasan claims his beard is part of his religious observance, but the prosecutor argued he's only been growing it since June. A court martial set for August 20 has been put on hold because of the beard issue.

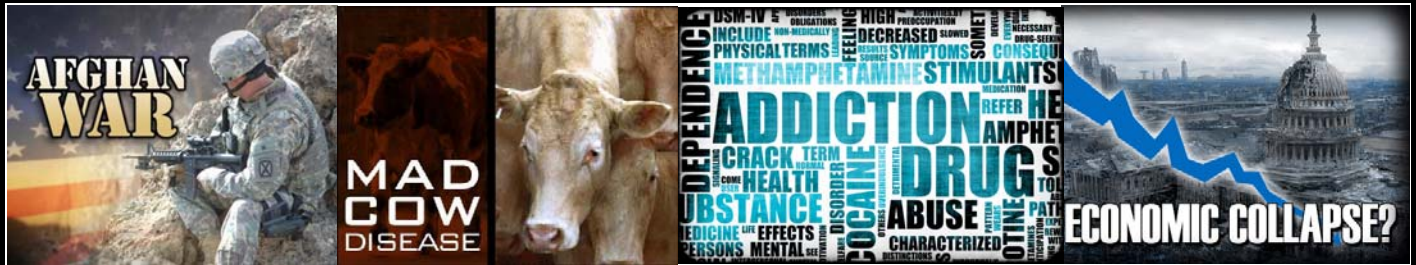
#### FOOTBALL SCHEDULES
